Residential treatment for sexually abusive adolescent males

Project Valor is a treatment program for ages 11 to 17, with an IQ of 70 and above. The program is designed around the core belief that adolescents deserve treatment for their sexually abusive behaviors in a strength-based environment. We believe that treatment can be maximized through individualized treatment planning that encompasses the adolescent's specific developmental issues, method of learning and individual strengths.

Services can include:

- Sexually abusive-specific group therapy
- Psychiatric evaluations
- Individual and group therapies
- Pharmacologic treatment
- Licensed and accredited education
- Aggression replacement training services
- Relapse prevention training
- Psychosexual evaluation
- Independent living skills training
- Polygraph evaluation
- Expressive therapies
- Weekly family therapy
- Therapeutic recreational therapy
- 24-hour nursing services
- Discharge/aftercare plans
- Social skills training
- Monthly family support group

We believe that within a positive peer culture, adolescent males can develop self-worth, significance, dignity and responsibility. We examine the youth's presenting problem, as well as other behavioral issues, psychiatric issues and educational needs in the development of the multidisciplinary treatment plan. Residents are surrounded by a community of caring professionals as they journey toward healthy sexuality and appropriate social behavior.
